In the name of Allah, the most Beneficent, the most Merciful.

A month back, I received a call from Zaim Ansar: Central Jersey- Abdul Nasir Sahib to take the responsibility of Muntazim Isha'at. Initially, I was a bit hesitant to take the responsibility due to my working hours; but I am certain that Allah swt will continue to guide me in fulfilling this commitment.

I feel it is important that our young generation knows about the humble beginnings of the Central Jersey Jamaat and how it grew to be the congregation it is today. I gathered some valuable facts through my conversation with Dr. Imtiaz Chaudhary Sahib who led the community as the President from 1980 to 2010.

Earlier, CEJ & North Jersey Jamaats were combined. As membership grew, the Center of Jamaat decided to establish CEJ as its own community in 2000.

Before the first Ahmadiyya mosque was established in New Jersey, our respected brothers used to hold meetings in the basement of Dr. Ahsan sahab's house in Teaneck, Brother Dr. Mohammad Sadiq later became the first president of CEJ jamaat. In February of 1988, Bait ul Wahid was established in Clifton, CEJ. A small space from its façade, but a strong foundation for the future of the Jamaat in Central Jersey. As the Jamaat was spreading its wings, Khalifatul massih Rabeh, (4th khalifa) visited the CEJ jamaat in 1989 and asked for the number of members; he was informed of a strong congregation of 206. Following that, the Huzoor also graced the jamaat in 1991.

A few years later, building on that foundation of faith, and inviting many more members, in 1998 the Central Jersey mosque- Baitul Hadi became the center for all members. And in 2008, a separate lajna hall was constructed for the sisters in our community. By the grace of Almighty our present majalis has more than 400 members.

My voyage would not have been complete without input from the current President Dr.


What should I do to protect myself from flu this season?

CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older as the first and most important step in protecting against this illness. In addition to getting a seasonal flu vaccine, you can take everyday preventive actions like staying away from sick people and washing your hands to reduce the spread of germs. If you are sick with flu, stay home from work or school to prevent spreading flu to others. In addition, there are prescription medications called antiviral drugs, e.g, Tamiflu that can be used to treat influenza illness.

Can the flu vaccine provide protection even if the flu vaccine is not a "good" match? (like this flu season)

Yes, antibodies made in response to vaccination with one flu virus can sometimes provide protection against different but related flu viruses. A less than ideal match may result in reduced vaccine effectiveness against the flu virus that is different from what is in the flu vaccine, but it can still provide some protection against flu illness. In addition, it's important to remember that the flu vaccine contains three or four flu viruses (depending on the type of vaccine you receive) so that even when there is a less than ideal match or lower effectiveness against one virus, the flu vaccine may protect against the other flu viruses. For these reasons, even during seasons like this one when there is a less than ideal match, CDC continues to recommend flu vaccination. Vaccination is particularly important for people at high risk for serious flu complications, and their close contacts.

A Faith-Inspiring Bait

This story was narrated by Naseer Alam sahib from North Jersey. On Friday, Jan 5, he noticed a stranger at the Friday prayers in the North Jersey masjid. Noticing a new face, he got closer to him and introduced himself. He learned that he was Mr. Giovanni from Bagota, Columbia and was visiting US. On inquiring, he mentioned that he was dissatisfied with his Catholic belief. He was surfing internet and was introduced to Islam by Mr. Nouman, an Ahmadi from Virginia, who met him on a blog. He was attracted to it but could not get hold of Ahmadis in Columbia as there were no mission house /Jamaat Centre in Columbia. It seemed like Mr. Giovani had already accepted ahmadiyyat at heart as he already had a downloaded Bait Form with him and was ready for a Bait. He also told Naseer Alam that he did not pray in the Catholic way on the funeral of his mother a month earlier.

He also mentioned that he was in US on a business trip and was staying in an Air B&B place in Newark. He found address of our masjid and called Uber to come to attend Friday prayers in Baitul Wahid, Hawthorne. Naseer Alam sahib gave him a cap to cover his head. He wanted to attend the Friday prayers but didn't know how to do it. Naseer sahib instructed him to pray in his own words. He joined the Jamaat for Friday prayers and followed the motions.

After Friday prayer he had a short meeting with Hafiz Sahib and desired for a Bait but Hafiz Sahib told him as he is in the US for a few days it is better to get familiar with Jamaat in person before signing a Bait. He agreed and it was decided that he should enjoy visiting some sights on Saturday and Naseer Alam would bring him back to Baitul Wahid, Hawthorne on Sunday, Jan 7 for North Jersey Monthly meeting.

Afterwards, Naseer Alam sahib dropped him back to his Air B&B. On Saturday, he had to move to Brooklyn because of some issues with his Air B&B. Since Brooklyn was quite far from North Jersey, Naseer sahib advised him to go to the Brooklyn masjid. Naseer sahib connected him through whatsApp with Saifullah Khalid, North Jersey Tableegh Sec., who introduced Mr. Giovanni to Brooklyn Tableegh Sec. On Friday, Jan 12, Mr. Giovani took Bait at the age of 34 years. A few days later, Naseer Sahib contacted him on WhatsApp and he replied,

"Walaikum assalam Naseer, yes I remember you how's life? I'm fine, working hard and studying. Reading again Jesus in India and understanding more things about Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, peace upon him. I confess I haven't been able to pray 5 times, but I do it and it gives me peace, I pray in Spanish mixed with Arab and English. My friend Eakan told me that is a

Naseer sahib mentioned that he had always heard stories about Allah Himself guiding people towards Jamaat but this was the first time he himself witnessed such an event which was very faithinspiring. Naseer Alam wishes to visit this "Righteous Spirit" in Bagota one day. Naseer sahib often brings his children to the Tahir Academy in Baitul Hadi.
